

EVENTS OFFERED

The race is approximately 1000m with a free start

Event categories will be set based on entries received in each boat class, according to the new PRI system.

As a guide, previous events at Borne regatta have included:

Nov, IM3 and IM2: 8+, 4x-, 2x, 1x

Nov and IM3: 4+

IM3 and IM2: 4- or 2-

Juniors: J14 and above

J14 only: 8x+, 4x+

Masters: Coxless sculling only

Mixed: 4+ only

All boats must be provided by competitors and clubs are responsible for the safety of their members and equipment. Neither MAABC nor Borne@Chiswick Bridge Regatta will accept liability

A minimum of three entries is required to guarantee the running of an event. If there are fewer than three entries, crews may be moved up a class or handicapped in the case of masters.

Please indicate on your entry form a second choice of boat class in case there are insufficient entries for your first choice.

All entries by use of the BROE system only and the entry fee is **£13** per seat (cox'ns free). Online payment preferred but cheques payable to 'Borne Regatta' will be accepted and should be received by the Entries Secretary no later than the date below.
